

Club Partnerships FAQ

Continuous | Queensland, Australia | Last updated 1 July 2026

Who can order?

Schools, universities, rowing clubs, masters crews and rowing organisations in Australia can enquire. New Zealand may be considered in future.

What products are offered?

Custom rowing zooties/unisuits only for now.

What is the minimum order?

The minimum order is 10 garments.

Are designs custom?

Yes. Each design is created for the club and is exclusive to that club.

Are design revisions included?

Yes. Design consultation and revisions are included with the project deposit.

Can every athlete choose their own size?

Yes. Each athlete can select their own size based on the available size chart and guidance.

What materials are used?

Club orders use the Continuous premium fabric base: 82% polyester, 18% spandex, 230 GSM, with four-way stretch, ventilated side panels and non-slip silicone leg grippers.

How long does it take?

Design usually takes 1-2 weeks. Sample production usually takes 3-4 weeks. Production after approval takes around 4 weeks, with delivery around 1-2 weeks.

Is a sample included?

A production sample is made at the club's expense before full production.

When do clubs pay?

A deposit is required to begin. The club pays sample cost. Production balance is due once production begins.

Can a club cancel?

If a club cancels after production begins, the order is non-refundable and the deposit may be kept.
